WASTE MANAGEMENT: GENERAL OBLIGATIONS



Sorting your waste by waste type.



Using the right bags and container by waste type.



Take your waste with you after the market. Take it to a registered collector or dispose them in your own containers.



Keep proof of good management, such as the collection contract, invoice, etc.

AT THE MARKET: YOUR OBLIGATIONS



Do you offer products for consumption, tastings or drinks? If so, install **sorting bins for your customers**.



Your stand and its immediate surroundings must be **kept perfectly clean during and after** the market.



Place bins (or other containers) in your stand to sort your waste.

IT IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN TO:

- ❌ leave waste behind on departure (rubbish, small pieces of paper, packaging, cardboard, used oil, etc.)
- ❌ throw your waste in the public bins or to abandon it in public places
- ❌ use the white bag, which is reserved for household waste from the general public



Failure to comply with these obligations may result in **administrative fines** or even suspension of business activities for several weeks.



SORTING YOUR WASTE IS A LEGAL OBLIGATION FOR ALL BUSINESSES. IN RETURN FOR YOUR EFFORTS, YOU CAN BENEFIT FROM:
